




Map of the Witch-Lands



Bloodmoss Ointment. This was taught to me by the Shaman at Turukhansk. Take six handfuls of bloodmoss and boil it with a thumb-sized piece of hump-flower root. When the root has turned black take the pot off the fire and let it cool. Press the bloodmoss as dry as you can and then steep it for three days in just enough grain-spirit to cover it. Meanwhile prepare some goose-grease by boiling and chilling alternately until it is clear and white and sets hard. Take the bloodmoss, squeeze it dry and pound it in a mortar, and then mix it with an equal quantity of the goose-grease. Seal it in a hollow with beeswax.
